

Banff Big 3 Sight-Seeing Tour: Moraine Lake, Lake Louise & Emerald Lake

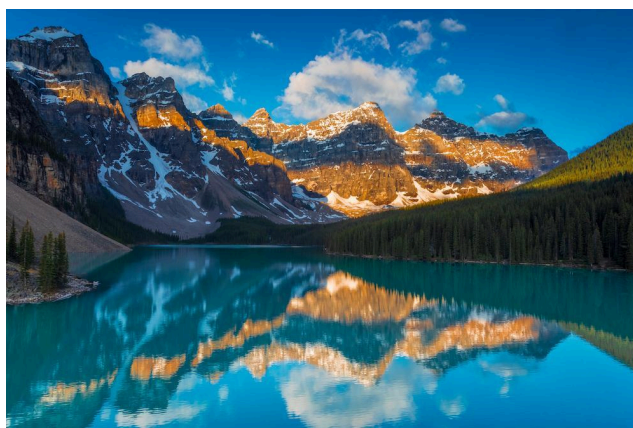
Round-Trip Day Tour to Moraine Lake, Lake Louise, Emerald Lake and Takakkaw Falls

11:00 am	Leave Lake Louise
11:20 am	Visit Moraine Lake
12:20 pm	Leave Moraine Lake
12:40 pm	Lunch* stop in Louise Village
1:15pm	Leave Louise Village
1:45pm	Visit Emerald Lake
2:45pm	Leave Emerald Lake
3:15pm	Visit Takakkaw Falls
4:15pm	Depart Takakkaw Falls
4:45pm	Lake Louise Village Drop off

What's included in my trip?

- A Professional Guide and Driver
- Private group transportation throughout
- Cold drinks and light snacks

What's not included in my trip?

- Stops not included in the itinerary
- Lunch
- Gratuity for Big Nature Guide/Driver
- Bottled water (water & reusable cups will be available)
- A mandatory Parks Canada Moraine Lake Access fee: \$20 per person

What should I expect?

- Temperatures ranging from 0° to 30° C (32° F to 86° F)
- Rain and possible snow
- High sun exposure
- Uneven terrain
- Possible delays in pickup / dropoff time due to traffic and road conditions
- Seating in van is first-come first-served

What should I bring?

- Hiking or good walking shoes
- A warm layer, rain jacket and pants
- Sunscreen
- Bug Spray
- A refillable water bottle
- Lunch (or money to purchase lunch in Lake Louise)
- Cash for a gratuity for the Big Nature Guide/Driver

What can't I bring?

- Pets (except accredited service animals)
- Glass bottles

Can I bring my children?

- Yes! Children under 5 are free, however you must provide a child seat that can be installed in the van
